

      - 4. Blue Tit, *Parus caeruleus* 859 ringed (max 176 ringed at 26.09)
        - 5. Great Tit, *Parus major* 831 ringed (max 139 at 26.09)
      - 6. Robin, *Erithacus rubecula* 724 marked (max 51 ringed at 27.09)
- 7. Long tailed Tit, Aegithalos caudatus 660 ringed (max 123 ringed at 09.10)
  - 8. Willow Warbler, *Phylloscopus trochilus* 523 marked (max 63 at 10.08)
  - 9. Wren, Troglodytes troglodytes 482 ringed (max 52 ringed at 27.09)
    - 10. Garden Warbler, Sylvia borin 191 ringed (max 39 at 10.08)

(Who, when and where have been ringing these birds?)

Note many Tits, *Parus sp.*, tropical migrants like Blackcap, Garden Warbler and some other species (Dunnock, Wren) trapped this season but from the other hand **low number** of Owls, Willow Warblers or Siskins.

#### Rarities in the nets:

Black Woodpeckers, *Dryocopos martius* – 11 have been ringed so far,
Bluethroat, *Luscinia svecica* – 1CY male ringed at 31.08
Common Crossbill, *Loxia curvirostra* – 1 ringed at 23.09
Goshawk, *Accipiter gentilis* (female 1CY) ringed at 14th of August
(2nd for Hammarö Fågelstation)

Great Grey Shrike, *Lanius excubitor excubitor* – 2 1CY have been marked Grey – headed Woodpecker, *Picus canus* – 3 1CY (male and 2 females) ringed,

House Martins, *Delichon urbica* – 3 ringed at 21.08, Marsh Tits, *Parus palustris* – 2 birds have been ringed, Pygmy Owls, *Glaucidium passerinum* – **15** have been ringed so far,

Red Knot, Calidris canutus (1CY) ringed at 30.08 (new species for Hammarö Fågelstation)

Sparrowhawks, *Accipiter nisus* – 10 in total have been ringed (only 1CY: 6 females and 4 males), Tangmalm's Owl, *Aegolius funereus* – 2 2CY have been ringed,

Three - toed Woodpecker, Picoides tridactylus -

10 have been ringed (only 1CY: 5 females and 5 males),

Towny Owl, Strix aluco (3CY+ and female 1CY) ringed at 05th and 8th of August

(2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> for Hammarö Fågelstation),

Twite, Carduelis flavirostris – 1 male 1CY was ringed at 13.10, Woodcock, Scolopax rusticola – 3 birds (1CY) have ringed, Wood Pigeon, Columba palumbus – 1 ringed at 21.08, Yellow Wagtail, Motacilla flava thunbergi – 1 male 2CY+ ringed at 21.08

## Occurrence of chosen species in autumn season 2007:

<u>Numberious</u>: Blackcap, **Blue Tit**, **Dunnock**, Garden Warbler, Goldcrest, **Great Tit**, Meadow Pipit, *Anthus pratensis* (19 ringed), **Robin**, Spotted Flycatcher (44 ringed), **Wren** 

<u>Low numberious</u>: Bullfinch, Siskin, Treecreeper, *Certhia familiaris*, Willow Tit, *Parus montanus*, Willow Warbler

# Best results in 2007:

#### Best year for

Dunnock – 1568 have been ringed so far, Great Tit – 831 ringed,
Three – toed Woodpecker – 10 have been ringed, Towny Owl – 2 have been ringed,
Tree Pipit – 1465 have been ringed, Wren – 482 have been marked so far

#### Best day for:

Common Whitethroat, Sylvia communis – 7 ringed at 6.08, Dunnock – 233 ringed at 18.09, Garden Warbler – 39 marked at 10.08, Great Tit – 139 ringed at 26.09, Spotted Flycatcher, Muscicapa striata – 18 marked at 24.08, Tree – toed Woodpecker – 3 ringed at 4th of October, Wren – 52 ringed at 27.09.
